





Producing incredible wine is Idaho's birthright, geographically speaking. With an ideal climate and near famous latitude for growing grapes, it's no wonder that the state is already home to over 65 wineries and cideries. A combination of the warm days, cool nights, and rich soil have drawn passionate and talented winemakers from all over to plant roots here. They create some of the most delicious and unique wine you'll ever taste, including classic varietals such as Syrah, Merlot, Malbec, Riesling and Chardonnay and more adventurous varietals like Tempranillo and Albariño.

Snake River Valley

The Snake River Valley American Viticultural Area (AVA), established on April 9, 2007, encompasses 8,263 square miles with 1,125 acres planted.

Overlaying ancient Lake Idaho, the shoreline creates its natural boundaries. The result is a distinctive winegrowing region whose ancient volcanic sediment has bestowed fertile, well-draining soil that gives growers better control throughout the growing process.









AMERICAN VITICULTURAL AREA

Lewis-Clark Valley

The Lewis-Clark Valley American Viticultural Area (AVA), established on May 20, 2016, encompasses 479 square miles with nearly 100 acres of grapes and approximately 20 unique varietals. The Lewis-Clark Valley is known as a temperate-climate area which produces high quality grapes. With a low elevation of 725 feet above sea level at the inland port of Lewiston, this part of Idaho is sometimes referred to as the banana belt of the state.






Eagle Foothills





The Eagle Foothills American Viticultural Area (AVA), established on December 28, 2015, encompasses 49,815 acres with 100 acres planted. This sub-AVA of the larger Snake River Valley AVA is the only one located completely within the state of Idaho. Nestled in the foothills north of Eagle, Idaho, the slope and aspect of the Eagle Foothills play an important role in sunlight reception, cold air drainage and protection from frost and wind. The unique granitic soils and local climate of this area contribute to the making of excellent wines.




Sunnyslope & Western Treasure Valley

With its rolling landscape, picturesque views and vineyard-dappled hills, it's no wonder the region attracts wine lovers from all over. In addition to its many geographical gifts, the Western Treasure Valley and Sunnyslope are home to unique wineries, one cidery, welcoming tasting rooms and festivals worth traveling for.

Eagle

The Eagle Foothills AVA has some specific geographical conditions that result in wine with lots of character. The slope and aspect of the Eagle Foothills play an important role in sunlight reception, cold air drainage and protection from frost and wind. The rolling hills and nearby Boise River also provide a picturesque backdrop for hiking, biking, kayaking, canoeing or simply strolling along while exploring the vineyards.


