Discussed IWC Legislative Educator, Roger Batt's contract renewal.

Discussed correction for Juls Germain's salary.

Hawkins moved to correct Juls Germain's salary from \$57,990 to \$ 58,500 dating back to the January 5th, 2025 pay period. Seconded. Motion carries.

Discussed IWC staff annual reviews.
