Sawtooth and Skyline Vineyards have a combined acreage of 412 acres making it the largest vineyard site in the state. They grow 25 different cultivars of winegrapes that are sold to clients for red, white, rose, and sparkling wine. This fruit is grown to meet winemaking needs that range from bulk production to ultra-premium wines.

Telaya started in 2008, when they produced 50 cases of carefully conceived wine. They've grown quite a bit since then. Their facility — which includes a full production space and tasting room — is located right on the Boise Greenbelt, just minutes from downtown and a few feet from the Boise River. Guests can enjoy tasting flights, glasses and bottles of their wine while overlooking the scenic river.
